CONTEST DETAILS

- Entries must be *received at Copperfield School by 3:30 pm on Wednesday, February 27th, 2019*
 - Entrants must be in Grades 4 to 8 at the time of the contest deadline
 - Entries must be written in English and must not exceed 21 lines
 - All entries must be original content – teachers are asked to ensure that all entries from their school were written by the student at their school
 - All entries must include a fully complete **ENTRY FORM**
 - Entries may be neatly handwritten or typed
 - All entries must be accompanied by supporting documentation including a first draft and evidence of revisions. These will not be returned. Please make sure each component is labeled accordingly (1st draft, good copy etc.) and that the final copy is placed on the top with the revisions and drafts in the back.
 - No faxed or emailed entries will be accepted
 - Due to the large volume of entries, we cannot acknowledge receipt of entry
 - Contest open to registered CBE students only
- The contest Winner will be notified via their Teacher-in-Charge and announced the day of the conference.**
