- In order to comply with Alberta's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) and the Copyright Act, the Calgary Young Writers Conference requests consent from parents to post, share or publish student work on the Conference Webpage.
- Once the art and/or writing examples are released on any public forum, the Calgary Young Writers Conference cannot control or prevent further distribution or use of the material by those who access the information.
- Parents are under no obligation to consent; it is their voluntary decision to do so. If you do not return this form, this indicates a refusal to consent. Parental consent is considered valid until April 1, 2020. You may withdraw your consent to post prior to posting or publication by notifying Allison Handelsman and Lisa Ly, Conference Chair, c/o Copperfield School in writing. Student work can be removed from the webpage at any time during the year by notification in writing in the same way.
