 - Entries must be written in English and must not exceed 1,500 words.
 - All entries must be original content – teachers are asked to ensure that all entries from their school were written by the student at their school
 - All entries must include all of the information on the **ENTRY FORM** below
 - Entries must be typed in a Google Document.
 - All entries must be submitted as a link to a Google Document. All work should be completed in this document so we can view the revision history for evidence of revisions. **The document should not be edited after submission.**
 - Due to the large volume of entries, we cannot acknowledge receipt of entry
 - Contest open to registered CBE students only
The contest Winner will be notified via their Teacher-in-Charge and announced the day of the conference.
